GHM SIGNS AGREEMENT ON A RESORT IN KOH CHANG



GHM has signed a management agreement with Aquarius International Development (AQI) to operate a 200-key resort on Koh Chang, the third largest island in Thailand.

The Chedi Aquarius Koh Chang will feature an all-day-dining restaurant, a cliff-edge restaurant, rooftop bar, spa, infinity pool with pool bar, and conference facilities overlooking the Gulf of Thailand.

Scheduled to open in 2023, the new Chedi would complement the brand's acclaimed hotels in Muscat (Oman), Sharjah (U.A.E.), Andermatt (Switzerland) and Luštica Bay (Montengro), as well as hotels under

development for the Maldives, U.A.E., India and Taiwan, all set to open in the coming year.

Though Koh Chang lacks the name recognition of either Phuket or Koh Samui, Thailand's largest and second largest island, its relative obscurity is partly a function of its natural splendour: A national park covers 83 percent of the island.

Readily accessible by air and by road from Bangkok, flights to the nearest airport in Trat take one hour; overland, the drive is 300 kilometres. The ferry from the mainland takes less than an hour.





IN SILOM - BANG RAK

Wake up a little earlier and feel the cooling winter breeze on a great weekend morning. Stretch a little and let's get ready to hang out in Silom – Bang Rak – Charoen Krung, the bustling districts with a lot of inspiring monuments of the bygone days.
























BANG RAK SHRINE

Bang Rak Shrine, or Chiao Eng Biao Shrine, is located just behind Bang Rak Market. It carries 150 years of Hainanese settlement in Siam, and it was built to honour 108 Chinese traders who were mistaken for pirates and were killed. As a result, the Bang Rak Shrine does not have a sculpture of a Chinese god or goddess as the principal deity, but has a nameplate depicting the words of the Deities of 108 Brothers instead.





WAT SUAN PHLU

Locally called Wat Klong Lorm, the historic temple is home to the statue of the Venerable Father Pa Lelai which is believed to shield the people of Bang Rak from bombardment during World War II. The monk's quarter has a blend of Thai and Chinese design with unique Thai roof and wood carvings.








BANGKOK MUSEUM

Since Charoen Krung 43 was once a bustling international district during late Ayutthaya period, Bangkok Museum depicts the diverse stories of the Bangkoknian and the international crowds before and after World War II. The museum is divided into 4 buildings, exhibiting the home of the bygone days with antiques furniture, tools, and home décors.





Old banknotes and coins are displayed in the separate hall while the library in the last building welcomes you to dive in and learn the history of this colorful city.



NEILSON HAYS LIBRARY

The neo-classical Neilson Hays Library has been the landmark of Bang Rak for almost a hundred years. With constant maintenance and restoration, it was officially awarded the "Historic Landmark" in 1986 by the Association of Siamese Architects. Dr Thomas Heyward Hays built this iconic library to honor his beloved wife who passed away unexpectedly. The design was the art of renowned architecture, Mario Tamagno, who also designed Hua Lamphong Station and Ananta Samakhom Throne Hall.

CENTRAL POST OFFICE: TCDC

It's hard to miss the imposing architecture of the Central Post Office, or the Grand Postal Office. The building houses Thailand Creative and Design Center (TCDC) with the center hall hosting variety of creative exhibitions. The gallery at the back and the beautifully landscaped rooftop garden are also open to the public.





PRINCE THEATRE HERITAGE STAY BANGKOK

Formerly a popular theater during 1940s, Prince Theatre Heritage Stay Bangkok was given a new life as a boutique hotel that recaptures the classical atmosphere of the landmark. Experience the sense of old Bangkok and learn about the early Chinese communities through the original architecture and the hotel's antique zone. Staying in this heritage hotel will be a beautifully nostalgic experience, but just dropping by at the Box Office Bar & Cinema Social Scenes to mingle, chill, eat, and drink with friends will also be the experience anyone would find memorable.



JEONGDONGJIN BEACH






Designed to be an iconic scenic rail route and guaranteed by the Guinness Book, Mukho runs between Gangneung, Samcheok, and Jeongdongjin Stations. The first 2 bogies are decorated in fun sea theme to lift up the whole seaside ride experience while the third bogie perfectly accommodates an amusing family ride. The seats are arranged towards the windows for you to sit back and enjoy the views. In addition to spectacular sea views, snacks and drinks are also available onboard.

SEORAKSAN NATIONAL PARK

Covering 354 km2 by the east coast of South Korea, Seoraksan National Park is the most popular national park of the country. The park is famous for its floral diversity, especially during spring when lives bloom, but the whole valley turns bright red and gold vibrant colors as autumn arrives. Winter, however, may seems a little quieter, but visitors still make their way to the mountain peaks to watch charming panoramas of the still forest covered in fluffy white sea of fog. Many interesting attractions called Seoraksam home like the historic Sinheungsa Temple and the Ulsanbawi mountain.

PINANG PERANAKAN MANSION

Built in 1890, the luxurious mansion was formerly the residence and office of Chung Keng Quee, one of the wealthiest men in 19th century Penang and the leader of Ghee Hin, a Chinese secret society. After the decline of his clan, the mansion was acquired by a property developer in 1990s and revived it as a museum dedicated to Peranakan culture. The interior is a seamless mix between sumptuous traditional Chinese and western design with more than 1,000 Peranakan antiques.

CLAN JETTIES FLOATING VILLAGE

The century old Chinese settlement literally sits on stilts over Penang waterfront. The former fisherman village is a part of Penang Heritage Trail and the breezy atmosphere makes it more enjoyable to explore the traditional lifestyle and try local dishes. There are 6 jetties, each named after a Chinese clan, with Chew Jetty being the UNESCO's World Heritage Site and the most tourist-friendly jetty.

PENANG HILL

Standing tall at 823 meter above sea level, Penang Hill, or locally known as Bukit Bendera, boasts spectacular views of lush tropical forest with amazing Penang city backdrop. The peaceful hill is also home to religious landmarks, including the Hindu Mosque Penang Hill and Penang Hills Mosque.


PENANG NATIONAL PARK




CARTACENA










SCENERIES OF







NEXT STATION



Flying to Faroe Islands (Vágar Airport) is possible from Copenhagen. The flight takes only around 2 hours and 15 minutes. The island is mostly cold throughout the year, with the summer mean temperature of 10 oC. The best period to visit is from April to July when the day is longer, and the temperature is relatively warmer. GASADALUR VILLAGE

Located on the western coast of Vágar Island near the daring cliff by the ocean, the tiny Gasadalur Village boasts marvelous panoramas of the intimidating Atlantic Ocean, Arnafiall Mountain, and Eysturtindur Mountain. The village main stream also flows straight towards the cliff and creates Múlafossur Waterfall falling down gently into the ocean.

Faroe Islands inherited the longstanding Viking tradition of whale hunting. The annual hunt begins from the end of June to early July to harvest pilot whale meat and oil for the winter. The tradition also ensures the marine ecology around the island. According to MarineBio, a wildlife conservation organization, pilot whale is not an endangered species and can only be hunted only in this tradition.



BØUR VILLAGE

An ancient city of Bøur Village only has the population of 65 people. The unique thatched roof homes set against the mountains backdrop on one side and the vast blue ocean on another is simply magical. However, the real highlight of the village is the daunting Drangarnir Gate and Tindhólmur.


