Traveling to Gunma from Tokyo is a breeze, with the Shinkansen bullet train taking less than an hour, while local trains and buses take approximately 2-4 hours, depending on your destination.

TAKASAKI

Takasaki is the central transportation hub of Gunma. The district is known for its distinctive Buddhist culture that is the birthplace of the Daruma doll, a popular Japanese good luck charm.



● Shorinzan Darumaji

Shorinzan Darumaji is an ancient temple that gave birth to the famous "Daruma" doll. Legend has it that a monk carved a wooden doll before drawing the eyebrows and a crane-shaped beard to symbolize longevity and good fortune. It's a tradition for visitors to purchase a Daruma doll and make a wish by filling in one of its eyes. If the wish comes true, they can fill in the other eye and return the doll to the temple. At the end of the year, a festival is held and all Daruma dolls are burned in a bonfire, while new ones are sold for the upcoming year.

● Byakui Daikannon Jigen-In

Take a breathtaking journey to admire the beauty of Takasaki city from the shoulders of the 42-meter high goddess statue, Guan Yin. This iconic symbol of Takasaki stands proudly in Jigen-In Temple, an ancient temple dating back to the Showa era in 1936, and a tourist hotspot. Besides the impressive goddess statue, the temple also boasts a unique church sanctuary filled with hanging lanterns. If you visit during the autumn season, you can also enjoy the surrounding garden filled with blooming sakura flowers and sculptures.

● Mount Haruna

Explore one of the most famous mountains in the region, collectively known as "Jomo Sanzan", which includes Mount Akagi, Mount Myogi, and Mount Haruna. Located in Takasaki, this dormant volcano has a distinctive bowl-like shape and is commonly referred to as Haruna Fuji. Visitors can hike or take a cable car to the 1,449-meter high summit to enjoy a fascinating view of the surrounding landscape. The mountain foot has a unique caldera shape, now transformed into a lake, where visitors enjoy activities such as boating and fishing for Wakasagi (Japanese smelt) and Ginhikari (Rainbow trout) during the winter season when the lake freezes over.

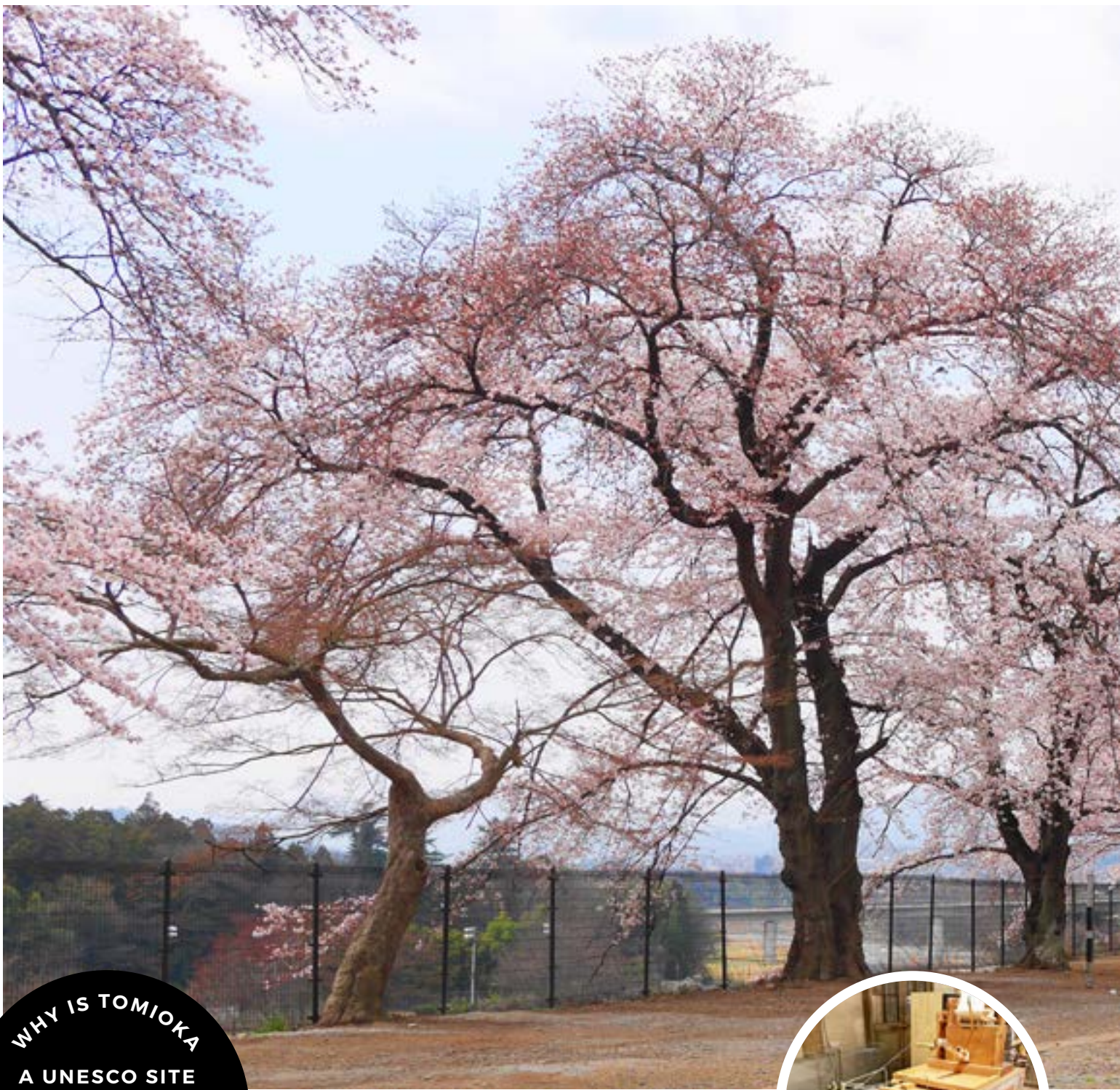

THIS HISTORIC BUILDING FROM THE MEIJI ERA HAS BEEN METICULOUSLY PRESERVED, ALONG WITH ITS VARIOUS MACHINES, INCLUDING SPINNING AND SILK-REELING MACHINES. THESE MACHINES WERE INSTRUMENTAL IN JAPAN'S TEXTILE INDUSTRY, AND TOMIOKA PLAYED A SIGNIFICANT ROLE IN THE DEVELOPMENT AND EXPORTATION OF SILK, ELEVATING JAPAN'S POSITION AS A LEADER IN THE GLOBAL SILK INDUSTRY.



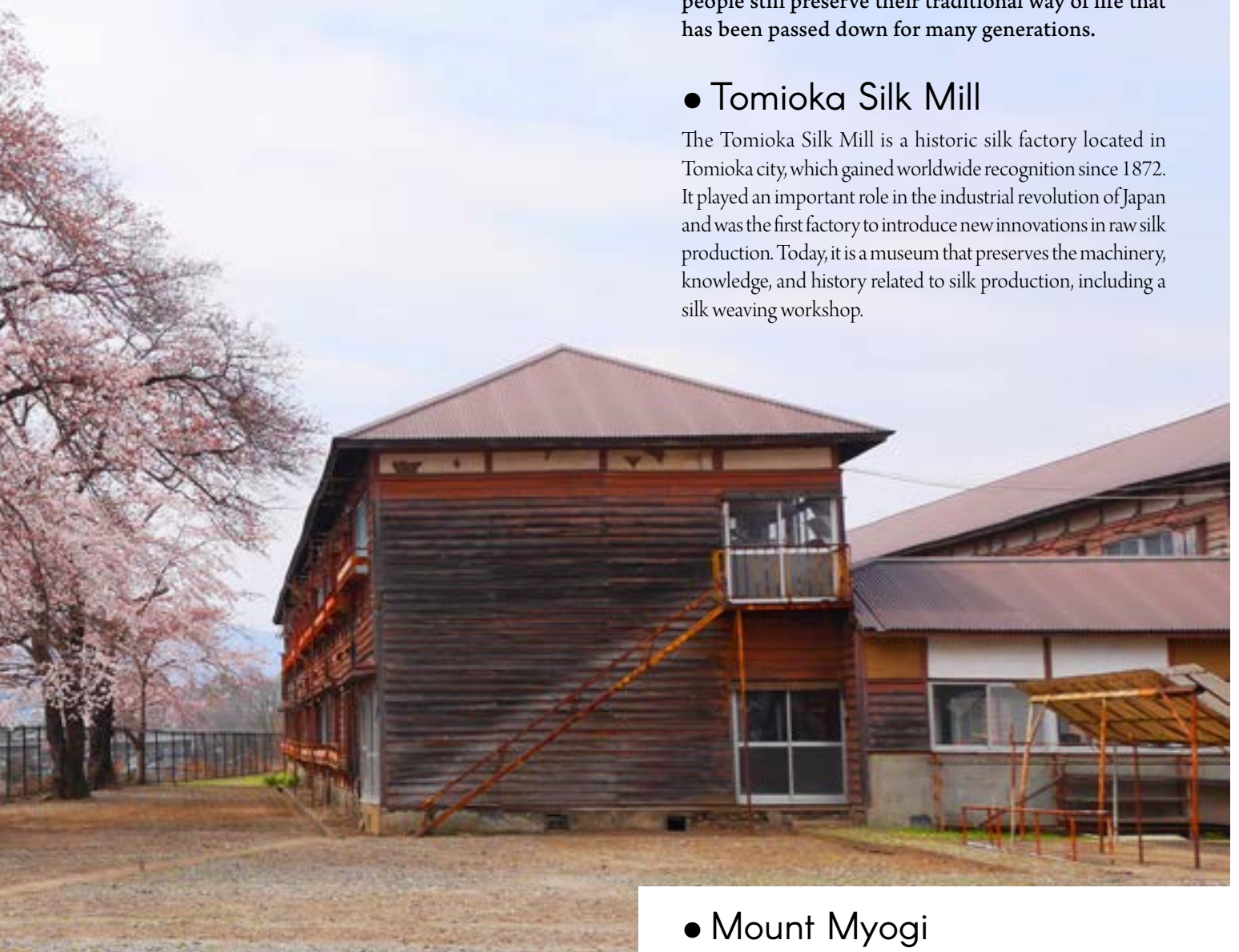

TOMIOKA

Tomioka is a historic town that marks the beginning of the industrial revolution in Japan. It is mostly a rural area with authentic Japanese-style farms producing high-quality silk products. The town's people still preserve their traditional way of life that has been passed down for many generations.

● Tomioka Silk Mill

The Tomioka Silk Mill is a historic silk factory located in Tomioka city, which gained worldwide recognition since 1872. It played an important role in the industrial revolution of Japan and was the first factory to introduce new innovations in raw silk production. Today, it is a museum that preserves the machinery, knowledge, and history related to silk production, including a silk weaving workshop.



● Mount Myogi

Mount Myogi is one of the three stunning mountains of Jomo Sanzan, and a paradise for mountain climbers. Indulge the breathtaking panoramic view of Sakura No Sato, a forest area with over 45 species of sakura trees, totaling over 5,000 trees, blooming beautifully along the mountain slopes. You can also explore the rugged rock formations and the majestic Myogi mountain peak standing at 1,104 meters high.

During your forest trek, don't miss the chance to visit the Miko Myogin Shrine, built during the Edo period to honor the local deities and to pray for victory in battles. If you visit during the autumn season, you can enjoy the vibrant colors of the leaves, decorating the mountain with an array of beautiful hues.

MAEBASHI

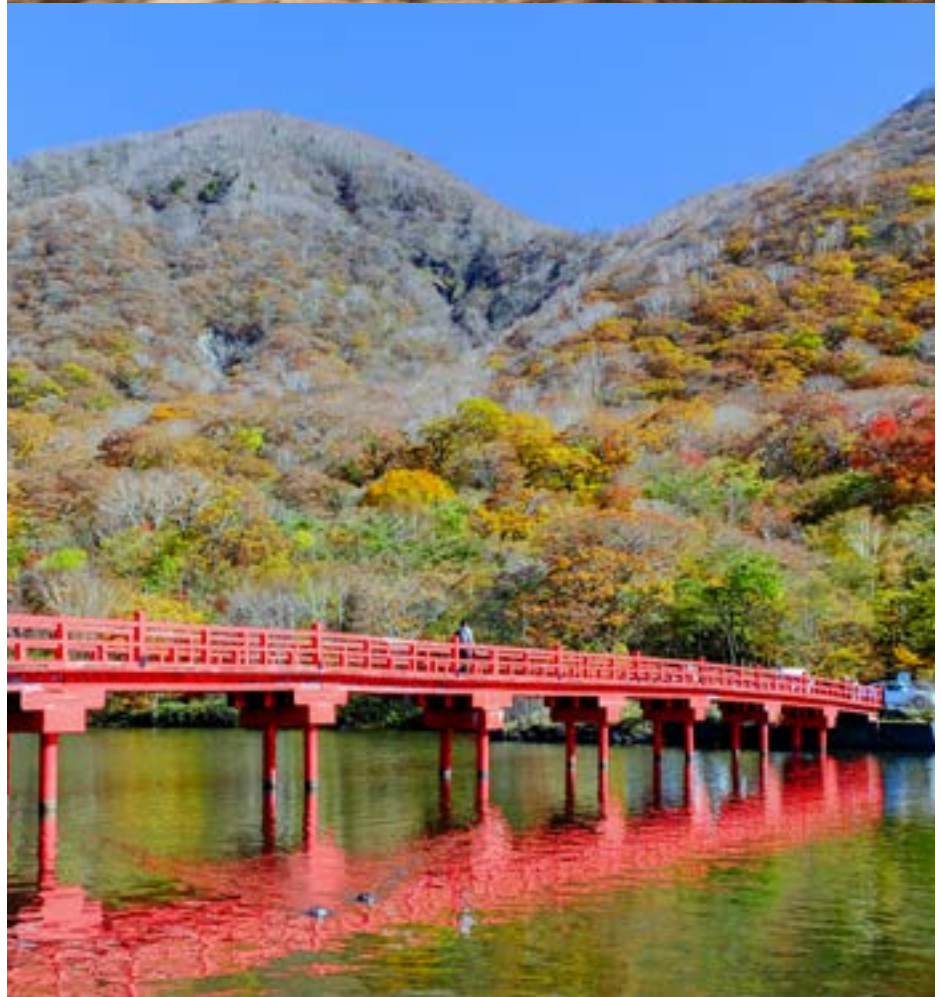

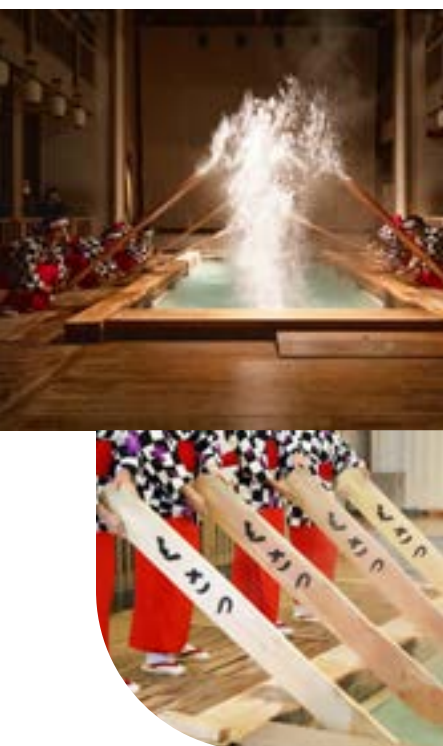
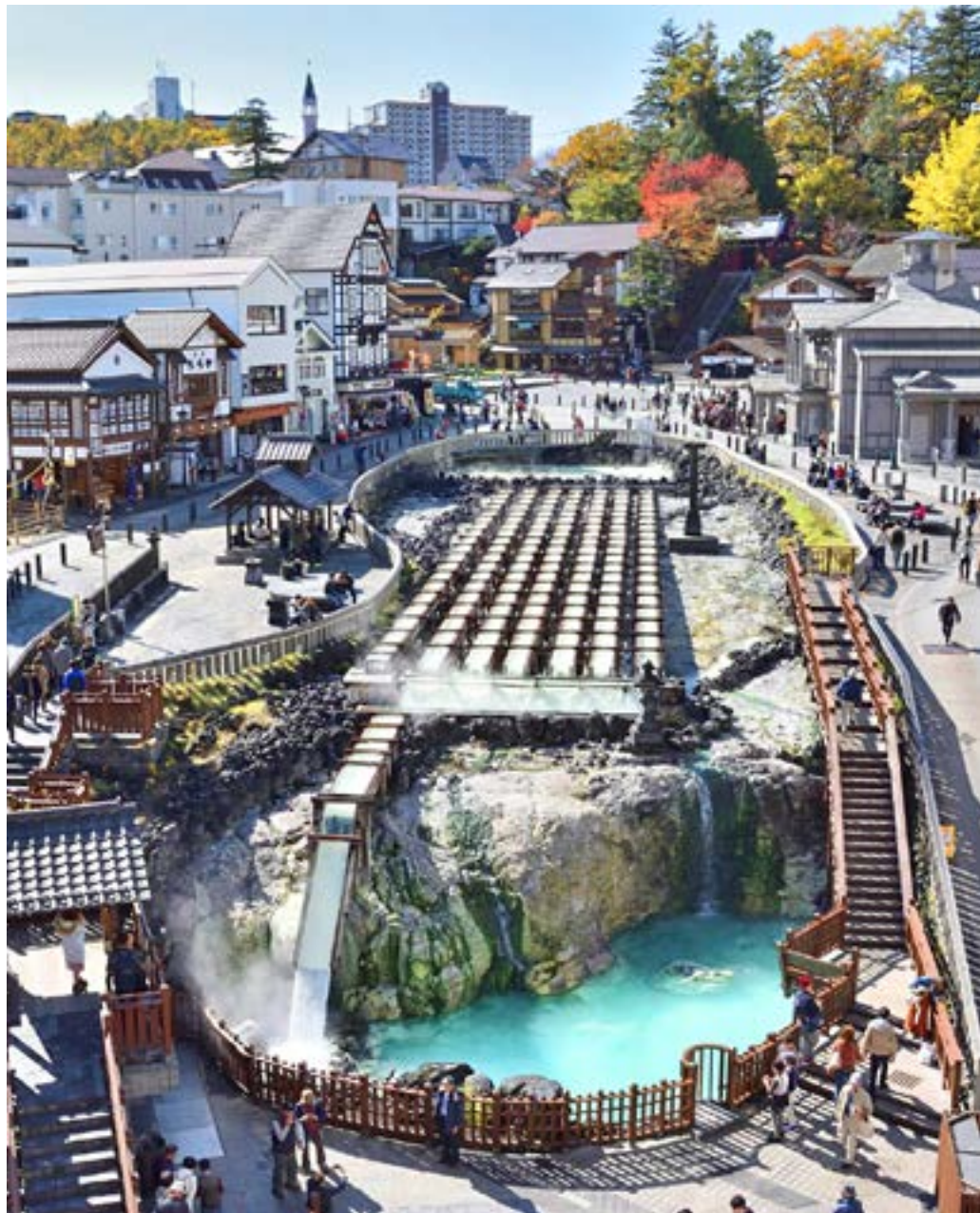
KUSATSU

Kusatsu is a renowned hot spring destination situated in the central part of Gunma Prefecture. With a history dating back to the Edo period, this town has successfully maintained its authentic Japanese ambiance and customs. Visitors can choose from a wide range of ryokans to stay in and enjoy the town's unique atmosphere. Onsens here boast exceptional qualities that are beneficial for those with allergies and skin conditions, as well as the ability to reduce the spread of new viral strains by up to 99%, according to research.

● Yubatake

Yubatake is a centrally located hot spring source in Kusatsu that is enclosed by stone walls and wooden bridges, perfect for scenic walks. The hot spring flows out at an impressive rate of 4,600 liters per minute and is collected at the "Yubatake" hot waterfall. From there, the hot water is distributed to ryokans and public bathhouses through seven wooden gutters called "Mokuhi." These gutters help regulate the temperature to maintain the mineral content and acidity of the water. At night, the area is beautifully lit up, and visitors can rent yukatas to capture the perfect Japanese festival experience.

DURING THIS PROCESS, VISITORS CAN ENJOY THE TRADITIONAL LOCAL FOLK SONGS CALLED "YUMOMI," WHICH ARE PERFORMED APPROXIMATELY FOUR TO FIVE TIMES A DAY, EACH LASTING AROUND 30 MINUTES.





NAKANOJO

Nakanojo is a charming countryside town situated amidst the stunning central mountains along the eastern coast of Gunma prefecture. It's renowned for its serene ambiance and breathtaking natural scenery, making it an ideal escape from the hustle and bustle of city life. The town is home to the historic Shima Onsen, as well as numerous traditional ryokans and other accommodations that will transport you back in time.

● Shima Hot Spring

Shima Hot Spring is an old onsen source that has been utilized for more than 1,200 years. The hot spring is known for its therapeutic properties of sulfur salt content, which is believed to be effective in treating wounds, nerve pain, fatigue, and up to 40,000 other medical conditions. The chewy snack is grilled and coated with Japanese-style sauce, resulting in a delightful combination of sweet and savory taste. 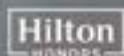

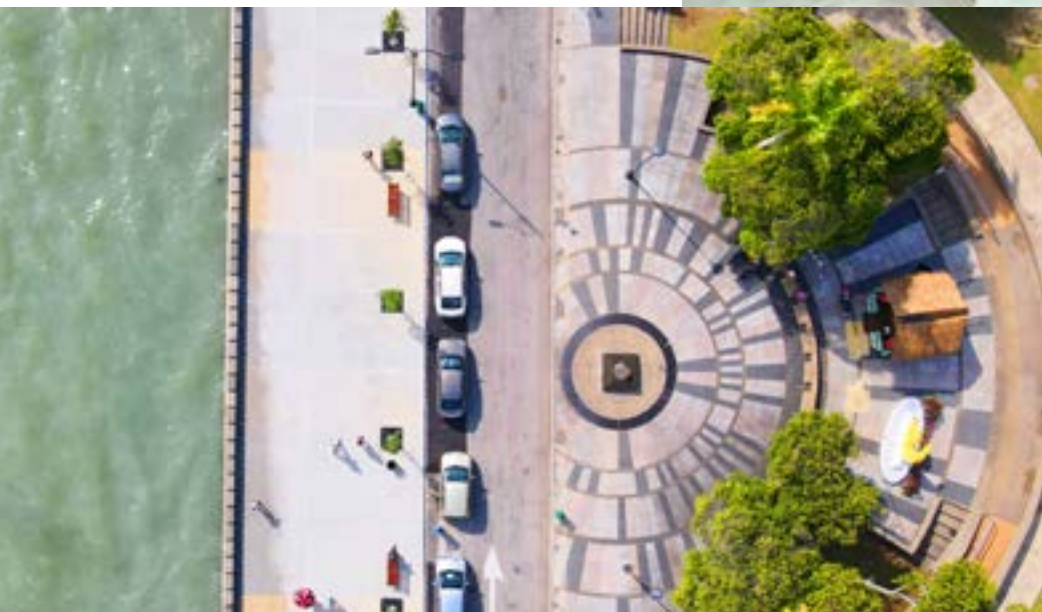
GEORGE TOWN

STREET ART CHECK POINTS

PENANG HILL

A natural heaven comprising botanical gardens, a national park, forest reserves, and a dam, Penang Hill has been designated as a UNESCO Biosphere Reserve, recognized for its invaluable conservation efforts. In the past, it served as a cool retreat for government officials and affluent merchants. To reach the summit of Penang Hill, visitors can board the region's oldest funicular railway, ascending through steep tunnels to a height of 823 meters. Once there, they can marvel at the 360-degree panoramic view of George Town and stroll along the skywalk of "The Habitat," a trail spanning over 1.6 kilometers. Immerse yourself in the lush rainforest ambiance and explore the diverse nature trails, where fortunate encounters with rare bird and animal species may occur. The Penang Hill, there are trendy bars and café available for service.



BATU FERINGGI BEACH

Penang still boasts a beautiful beach known as Batu Feringgi Beach, also referred to as Golden Beach. This golden sandy stretch spans over 5 kilometers and is located just 15 kilometers north of George Town. It is a renowned holiday destination and a hub for luxurious 5-star accommodations. CHEONG FATT TZE'S BLUE MANSION

Cheong Fatt Tze's which was awarded the UNESCO's Most Excellent Project Asia Pacific Heritage Awards in 2000, is also known as "The Blue Mansion." It was formerly mansion of a prominent figure, during the establishment of the Penang Straits Chinese enclave. This architectural marvel showcases a blend of Chinese and European influences, with its striking deep blue color that captivates the eye. The mansion boasts a total of 38 rooms, some of which have been converted into accommodations known as The Blue Mansion, offering a unique experience for tourists. Visitors can explore the mansion and admire the valuable collection of antique furniture and household items on display.

PINANG PERANAKAN MANSION

The most famous museum in Georgetown is the former residence and office of Captain Chung Keng Kwee, a prominent figure in the 19th-century tin mining industry and leader of the secretive Chinese secret society, Hai San. This museum is a magnificent blend of Chinese and English architectural styles, representing the epitome of classical elegance. Inside, it houses over 1,000 preserved artifacts and collectibles. Visitors are allowed to the museum, but prior permission is required for photography.

PENANG TOWN HALL & CITY HALL

Not far from Peranakan Mansion is the location of the World Heritage Building, the Penang State Assembly Hall. It is an architectural of the British Empire, characterized by its light yellow and white alternating colors. Additionally, the City Hall, a prominent white building in the Colonial style, stands out with its Greek columns and large windows. These two buildings showcase the grandeur and influence of the British colonial society from the 17th to the 19th centuries.

FORT CORNWALLIS

An ancient fort located along the seaside, stands directly across from the Town Hall and City Hall. It was constructed in the late 18th century and named after Charles Cornwallis who established the British settlement in Penang in the late 1700s. The fort served as the largest fortification in Malaysia, with its walls standing 10 feet high and forming a star-shaped perimeter. Within the fort, various original structures that are over a hundred years old can be seen, including a chapel, a prison, an ammunition store, a barracks, an old flagpole, and the famous Sri Rambai Cannon. The Sri Rambai Cannon, believed to have been built by the Dutch in 1603, is said to bring good fortune and fulfill one's wishes when touched. Additionally, visitors can capture memorable photos with the Queen Victoria Memorial Clock Tower located nearby.

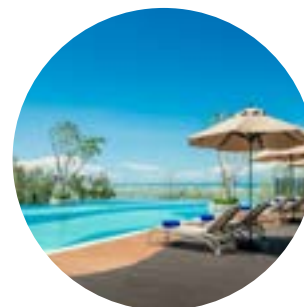

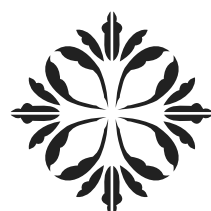
